**September 21, 2012**

The Haldeman Mansion Preservation Society has been awarded a \$2,500 check by the Gooding Group Foundation, gsm Roofing, Ephrata, PA to put towards the replacement of an aging, temporary roof that was installed on the Haldeman Mansion several years ago. The iconic, historic Mansion is the birthplace of the world renowned 19th century American Naturalist and Linguist Samuel S. Haldeman. Nine nonprofit organizations will be benefiting from the Giveaway, from receiving 20 hours of free repairs to a complete roofing project.
